# The RED LOOK

**R**ed is a strong accent this season and you can get away with wearing it from head to toe if you have the personality to match. Grab attention in solid colour dresses or separates, such as blouses and skirts. But also pick items that use red as a design element in pleats, lace and stitching details.

## HOW TO WEAR IT
